### Major Scale Information

- Major scales are called by key name **NOT** concert pitch
- Articulation Legato tongue up and down
- Rhythm Quarter note plus eighth note in the number of octaves as detailed below
- **Tempo** Quarter note equals 100 bpm (winds); quarter note equals 160 bpm (mallets)
- Snare All 26 N.A.R.D rudiments open-closed-open AND concert roll (pp < ff > pp)
- **Timpani** Tuning/sight-reading (no electronic tuner allowed); may use a pitch pipe, tuning fork, or mallet instrument
