Our staff is the same, Scott Lewis is the Assistant Director, Gage Freeman will instruct percussion and Heather Carmona will be the color guard instructor.

We hope to grow our ensemble and program with your participation. With hard-work and dedication, there’s no reason this band can’t continue to be one of the top groups in the region! Here are some important dates to keep in mind:

- June 16 - July 30: Thursday Summer practices
- Aug, Sept, Oct, Nov Friday nights: possible football games (see schedule below)
- Saturdays throughout October: Competition Dates
- Oct 8: George Wythe Band Festival (Parents, we need your help!!!!)

Obviously, we perform and function better when we have a high level of attendance. Students are expected to attend all performances. Summer practices need to be attended if students are not out of town or have a previous commitment. ALL absences must be approved by a director **PRIOR** to the date to be excused. **BAND CAMP IS MANDATORY FOR ALL MARCHING MEMBERS.** Three unexcused practices may result in dismissal from the ensemble. **ANY UNEXCUSED ABSENCES FROM A PERFORMANCE MAY BE CAUSE FOR DISMISSAL FROM THE ENSEMBLE.**

Financial Responsibilities

The GWHS Mighty Maroon Marching Band is committed to providing the absolute best experience possible for each of its members. In addition to the amount of time and effort needed to participate, comes an added expense that is required to make this organization possible. ***We do not want this to be the deciding factor on whether your child participates.*** Our Band Booster Club will offer fundraising opportunities that can be used to help cover some of the costs below.

- **Band Camp Fee - \$200.00**
 - This helps to cover the band shirt we will wear under the uniform, a show shirt for competitions, uniform cleaning, instructional staff, costs to run Band Camp, meals provided, etc.

*****A Deposit of \$50 is due by May 31*****

- **Additional Show T-Shirt – approx. \$18**
 - Additional Show Shirts can be purchased for friends & family.

Payment Schedule (to be paid in full by band camp):

- **By May 31: \$50**
- **By June 30: \$50 (\$100 TOTAL)**
- **By July 31: \$50 (\$150 TOTAL)**
- **By August 31: \$50 (\$200 TOTAL)**

WINDS/PERCUSSIONIST

- **Marching Band Shoes - \$35**
- Returning members will only need to purchase shoes if they have outgrown or lost their current pair.
- **Marching Gloves (Winds Only) - \$6.00**
- **Marching Flip Folders/Lyres - \$6.00 to \$12.50 (Extra Sleeves \$.60)** This price varies depending on which instrument.

COLOR GUARD

- **Guard Shoes - \$30 to \$55**

This price varies depending on the shoe brand used. These shoes are for Color Guard Members Only.



Common Questions About Marching Band

Q: When does the band practice start?

A: The band will practice after school on Mondays, Tuesdays, and Thursdays from 3:30 to 5:30 PM. A summer schedule is enclosed. All events and times are also on our band website.

Q: Are band events well chaperoned?

A: Nothing is more important than the safety and security of our students. Students will always be well supervised. Parents are invited to chaperone on our band trips.

Q: What is Band Camp?

A: Band Camp, August 1 – August 5, is the week the students learn the competition show. Practice is from 7:30 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. and held at George Wythe High School. This week is mandatory for anyone participating in the Marching Band.

Q: How much does Marching Band cost?

A: The Band Camp fee is \$200. This helps cover the show T-shirt, uniform cleaning, instructional staff, and all the other costs of running Band Camp. New members will be to purchase a pair of black marching shoes, gloves, and a maroon football t-shirt. All these items are purchased through the band.

Q: When are the band competitions?

A: The band will compete in Saturday competitions throughout October. The Band will compete in four competitions and host the George Wythe Band Festival on October 9.

Q: Will my child's grades be affected by marching band?

A: Over the years, I have found that band students maintain very high grades. The majority of the students involved in marching band are honor students.
