All Scales

- Tempo Quarter note equals 100 bpm
- Major Scale Articulation Legato tongue up and down
- Chromatic Scale Articulation Slur up, tongue down (except trombone; legato up, staccato down)
- Rhythm Quarter note plus eighth note (major scales); all sixteenth notes (chromatic)

Major Scales

Junior High level students are required to know the following major scales (listed by concert key)

Bb Eb Ab Db G

* scales will be asked by their transposed name (not concert pitch) in auditions

Flute: All scales two octaves (Bb, Ab are one octave)

Bb Clarinet: All scales two octaves (D, Eb are one octave)

Bass Clarinet: All scales one octave (G, F are two octaves)

Oboe: All scales one octave (C is two octaves)

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Bassoon: All scales one octave (F is two octaves)

Saxophones: All scales one octave (C is two octaves)

Trumpet, Baritone (TC): All scales one octave (G is two octaves)

French Horn: All scales one octave (G is two octaves)

Trombone, Baritone (BC), Tuba: All scales one octave (F is two octaves)

Percussionists will audition on all three instruments on the following material:

Snare: First 13 Rudiments (N.A.R.D/Ludwig) open-closed-open

Mallets: All scales (2 octaves)

Timpani: Tuning

Chromatic Scale

Flute: Low C to High G (2 octaves and a 5th)

Bb Clarinet: Low E to High C (2 octaves and a 6th)

Bass Clarinet: E to G (2 octaves and a 3rd)

Oboe: C to C (2 octaves)

Bassoon: F to F (2 octaves)

Saxophones: C to C (2 octaves)

Trumpet, Baritone (TC): G to G (2 octaves)

French Horn: G to G (2 octaves)

Trombone, Baritone (BC), Tuba: F to F (2 octaves)

Mallets: Full range of the instrument
